#### Lucie & Simon, Silent world






### Room No. 6219 Awaking by Art vol.2

#### OSAKA-HAMBURG 25th Anniversary

Including the installation drawn with sand exhibited in Documenta 10, a Hamburg-born artist, Mariella Mosler, presents new expressions, using different materials such as sugar and gum in each work. A Osaka-born artist, Rikuo Ueda, exhibited the wind drawings mainly in Europe and the United States since the late 1990s, and works based in Hamburg. It will be a Japanese-Germany exhibition of the two artists, who have the connection to Hamburg and work internationally. Port Gallery T in Higobashi will held an exhibition and artist talk as the related programs.


